<u>Geraldton –</u>

A few people have asked me about Geraldton and what it is like living here. It's a smaller community than the suburbs of Perth, and to us the people are friendlier than in the big city. However, there is also a rather large crime rate for a city of this size that we didn't know about before we moved here. Last December, the largest drug bust in Australian history occurred from a ship landing here loaded with methamphetamine. The street value would have been approximately one billion dollars. We also live near a poor section of the city and see children neglected and thus they are unruly. The police quite often have road blocks testing for drink driving. Today, Frank was trying to go get groceries in the a.m. and ended up in the middle of a police chase. We know that crime occurs all over the world and seems to be increasing, yet we are seeing it up close more often than we have before here in Australia. On the other hand, we have also had more visitors to services here than we have ever had. They don't always keep coming, but at least the word is getting out about our worship services. We pray for this community and so many others like it. ---That the Gospel would go forth and souls would be saved.
